Prior to assuming the presidency of the SSA in 1996, Ms. Owen served for 11 years as the executive director of the Visual Arts Center of Richmond, Virginia. She has significant professional experience in the fields of business and education, and began her career as a teacher. She holds an MFA from Virginia Commonwealth University, an MS in Art Education from Minnesota State University, and a BA in Art & Political Science from Luther College in Iowa. Ms. Owen has continued her professional education throughout her career in board leadership, museum management, and human resource

management, among related topics. She is a published arts writer, has served on many national boards and panels, and continues her work in the studio. She currently serves on the Board of Centro San Antonio as well as other civic organizations.

In her talk to the San Antonio Rotary Club, "50 Years of Art and Urban Revitalization-and Counting!," Ms. Owen will tell the story of the Southwest School of Art's remarkable growth as it prepares to celebrate its 50th Anniversary in 2015. In doing so, Ms. Owen will recount how an intrepid group of women worked together to preserve an important historic site-the former Ursuline Convent and Academy and thereby became a catalyst for further economic, cultural, and social revitalization in downtown San Antonio. Over the past 18 years of Owen's administration, the Southwest School of Art has also gained increasing recognition for the quality of its governance and operations, educational programming and facilities for all ages, outstanding exhibitions of contemporary art, the many distinguished professional artists who have been involved, and its continued preservation of the historic site.

Joe Straus Speaker of the House Texas House of Representatives

The Honorable Joe Straus has been Speaker of the Texas House since January 2009, elected to that post by his colleagues at the start of the last three legislative sessions. As Speaker, Joe Straus has set a tone of respectful leadership, empowering the members of the Texas House to do what is right for their constituents and for the people of Texas.

Speaker Straus believes in a limited, efficient government that is accountable to taxpayers. He wants to expand opportunity for all Texans by promoting economic development, improving education, increasing budget transparency, and securing the resources and infrastructure needed for private-sector growth. He regularly encourages his colleagues to work together, across partisan and geographic divides, to provide thoughtful solutions to the most serious challenges facing the state.

In addition to serving as Speaker, he represents Texas House District 121, which includes the Bexar County communities of Alamo Heights, Olmos Park, Terrell Hills, and northeast San Antonio. Speaker Straus was first elected to the Texas House of Representatives in a special election in February 2005.
